Open Meeting Minutes

Thursday November 11, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 11:00am by chairman Bill Bridges, Also, in attendance were board members: Mark Donahue, Greg Moore, Sue Williams, Jeff Pierson, Dave Neth

The meeting minutes from October 14, 2021, were approved by Greg Moore, 2<sup>nd</sup> Jeff Pierson, motion passed unanimously.

Introduction of Board Members/Replacement of Board Members. Bill ask the Board members to introduce their selves. Sue Williams accepted the appointment as a new board member, pending the County Commissioner approval. We still need one more board member and a secretary.

Greg Moore reported the Don Zuck Arbor is up and the last of the roof is ready to put on. We need a picnic table. Two fires were set on the concrete with slight damage to the concrete.

The County Commissioners are handling talking to the Idaho Fish and Game Dept. about a "Dusk until Dawn Ordinance" for the Yingst Grade Parking area.

Mike Tylka said he received a letter from the Jerome Highway district that the 20 mph signs the board put up were illegal and needed to be removed. Jeff French said he would go to the highway dept meeting and ask them to put up speed signs. Several suggestions on what to say to the Highway Commissioners were given to Jeff. Bill said he would also go to the Highway dept meeting on Nov. 18.

Sue Williams had a very good presentation on her proposal for the RV park. The grant request has to be in by Jan. 28, 2022. Sue needs the County Commissioners and the BLM on board ASAP. Roger Morley Arbor would be day use only. The RV sites would be north west of the Arbor with a loop at the north end to turn around. North of this would be a horse RV area with 5 corrals for the horses.

The board was informed that the possible land conveyance from BLM to SRCP issue is still alive.

Mike Tylka informed the board that construction of the disc golf course is mostly complete. Pads are poured and Mike is digging and setting the supports for the baskets. We have received \$4000 from sponsors and 2 x \$500 checks each for ½ a hole. The checks are in our bank account.

The next Park Board meeting will be held at the Caddy Shack restaurant on Thursday Dec. 9, 2021 (second Thursday of the month) from 11am-1pm. Pending approval from the Commissioners.
