Open Meeting Minutes

Thursday March 10, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 11:00am by chairman Bill Bridges, Also, in attendance were board members Lexi Roth, Greg Moore, Jeff Pierson, Sue Williams and potential board members Steve Paulsen and Mike Zobott

Since all board members were not present at the start of the meeting: Mike Tylka was ask to be a voting member for this meeting.

Addition to Agenda: None

The meeting minutes from Feb. 10, 2022, were approved unanimously.

Introduction of Board Members/Replacement of Board Members. We had the Board members and Visitors introduce themselves. Steve Paulsen and Mike Zobott have not been approved by the county commissioners, yet.

Mike Tylka reported on the Disc Golf course and the money in our bank account.

10,816.21 in our account.

Larry Hall presented his ideas for the broken bridge and repairing the Yingst Grade road. This project will cost ~\$300,000. Codie Martin was ask about getting the easement updated for Yingst Grade. The board voted unanimously to go forward with this project.

Larry Hall presented his plans for the Shoshone Falls Overlook. The board would like to do this project but needs more direction from Larry Hall. The board is looking for a step by step of what needs to be done. Idaho Power and the county both need to support this project with \$250,000/year for two years.

Sue Williams presented a spread sheet for plans for the next few years. After a short discussion, this was postponed to the next meeting. Sue ask that all board members study the spread sheet and put their own priorities down so we can discuss at the next meeting. We agreed to start the April 14 meeting at 10 AM to give lots of room for discussion.

Lexi Roth reported on the SRCP Webpage. Lexi ask that all board members review the Web Page and give suggestions for improvement.

Bill Bridges called IDT to get signs on US 93. Bill was told we had to meet 4 criteria. One was be nationally recognized, Shoshone Falls and the Emigrant Trail both meet this. Four was have drinking water and

toilets which we do not have at this time. This will be questioned by the County Commissioners as other signs on the road do not have number four either.

Bill Bridges brought up security in the park.

Bill Bridges ask board members for ideas on newspaper articles. We would like to have an article in each newspaper monthly to get the word out about our park. The second article will appear in the March issue of the North Side Journal. The article is about plants in the park.

The park clean up will be in May, 21, 2022.

The next Park Board meeting will be held at the Caddy Shack restaurant on Thursday April 14, 2022 (second Thursday of the month) from 10am-1pm.
